Thank you for your food donation of 80 pounds during the year 2010, which City Harvest distributed free of charge to community programs feeding hungry men, women, and children in New York City.

You are part of a dedicated group. More than 2,300 food donors have joined City Harvest in the fight against hunger. Thanks to donations from food establishments throughout the city and across the country, this year City Harvest will rescue 28 million pounds of unused, healthy food. Delivered to some 600 programs throughout the five boroughs, this food helps emergency feeding programs keep their doors open for the many individuals and families that struggle to put food on the table.
