To enter the tournament it is a \$10 donation per entry. A person can enter multiple teams but each entry is \$10 donation. Errol will send you the link to the website that you can log onto and make your picks for the whole tournament all 65 games. The tournament bracket comes out Sunday, March 11 you have until Thursday, March 15 at 11:00 a.m. to select your brackets and lock in and save your picks. The entrance fee is a donation of \$10 a person.

The winner will be the person who has the most points at the end of the tournament. The tournament runs from Tuesday, March 13 -Monday, April 2.

In the case of a tie the #1 tiebreaker will be the person closest to the Total score of the championship game. The #2 tiebreaker will be the person who picks the Winning Team. The #3 tiebreaker will be the person who picks the most teams in the final four. The #4 tiebreaker will be the person who picks the most teams in the Regional Finals

The breakdown of the tournament winnings will be as follows: 50% of the total Ppot will go to the winner. 30% of the total pot will go to the Charity, Paul Newman's *A whole in the wall gang camp*. 20% of the total pot will go to the person who comes in 2nd Place.

The tournament is open to Pythians and Non Pythians alike.
