


## *Pythians* Collect Supplies & Cash for those affected by Sandy

New York Grand Lodge supports <u>charities</u>, including the <u>Pythian Humanitarian Fund</u>, <u>Diabetes Research Association</u>, <u>Pythian Camp</u>, <u>Dr. Morris Smoller Social Service Fund</u> (which supports health and elder care institutions) and the <u>Special Olympics</u>.
