

## Important Notice from our Foundation concerning Student Scholarships

Our Foundation held it annual February 24. At this meeting we discussed a matter which many had been talking about for several months. For many years, the scholarship available through FDR's foundation applied to children and grandchildren of members. Until very recently, applicants were generally children of members; some were simultaneously children and grandchildren of members. Last June all of the scholarships were awarded to grandchildren of members. Grand Lodge has always awarded scholarships to qualifying children. Indeed in each of the last two Pythian Knights (which I also co-edit), included an article urging grandfathers to make sure their grandchildren's dads joined the order to qualify the worthy students for the Grand Lodge Scholarship.

The aim was to focus granddads to get their sons and sons-in laws to join the order to make their grandchildren (the children of their sons and sons in law) eligible to apply to this award from Grand Lodge. Indeed, it remains a worthy reminder why grandfathers may want to bring their sons and sons in law into our order.

Well, FDR's foundation, Kings-FDR Tolerance Foundation, voted to implement this same eligibility requirement; starting in January 2018, to qualify for a scholarship the student must be a child of a member (so if you want you grandchild eligible and the dad is not in this lodge, please see the notice above and act accordingly.
