Notice of Proposed Amendment to FDR Bylaws

Pursuant to the provisions of the Bylaws of FDR Lodge 613, please be advised of the following proposed amendment to the FDR Lodge 613 Bylaws:

This amendment to these Bylaws proposes to delete first sentence of Article II, Sec. 4. that reads "The hour of the opening of regular stated conventions shall be at eight-thirty (8:30 p.m.)."

As a result of this amendment, the lodge may hold meetings an an earlier or later meeting time than the current 8:30 p.m. time required pursuant to the Bylaws. This proposed amendment was presented at the October 12 meeting of FDR Lodge 613.

Pursuant to the ByLaws, the required first and second readings of the above amendment occurred at the October 12 meeting, and the required third reading and vote will take place at the November 9, 2018 Meeting. Please see the Bylaws provision governing amendments below:

Article X: Amendments

Section 1. A proposition to alter, add to or amend these By-Laws shall be submitted in writing, and signed by at least five (5) members of this Lodge who are in good standing. Such proposition upon presentation, must clearly state the present provision of the By-Laws and the exact language to which it is to be changed. Such proposition shall have three (3) readings, the first (1st) and second (2nd) of which may be held at the time of its presentation, but the third (3rd) reading and vote thereon shall be held after due notice to the general membership of the date when the vote will be taken. At least five (5) days notice of such vote shall be given to every member of the date when the vote will be taken. After the third (3rd) reading, and before the vote is taken, the proposition itself may be altered, added to or otherwise amended by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the valid votes cast, provided that such alteration, addition or change, is not contrary to the general intent of the proposition. If two thirds (2/3) of the valid votes cast in such final vote concur to the proposition, it shall be declared adopted subject to the approval of the Grand Chancellor.
